In addition to publishing articles on canonical and much-taught literary works, the *Encyclopedia* is also interested in making available information about important writers and works that are often neglected, and in publishing articles about discrete historical events which are relevant to the understanding of literary context. It also seeks to broaden its scope to include more research-oriented articles with a pedagogic function, such as 'Critical issues in *title*' or 'Critical readings of *author/ title*'. All offers of contribution should come accompanied by an up-to-date CV and, in the case of doctoral students who wish to offer a contribution, also a short writing sample. The overwhelming majority (about 90%) of our contributors are academic scholars, while the remaining percentage is made up of highly endorsed doctoral students and independent researchers.
